It is a malbec that reflects the Altamira terroir and our own Single Vineyard.

Appellation:

Paraje Altamira, Valle de Uco, Mendoza.

Characteristics of the single vineyard:

11 years; loamy-sandy soils, with alluvial stone 75 cm deep, with calcareous deposits.

Harvest 2019:

A season of low rainfall in spring and long summer. Average yields, healthy and very ripe fruit. Intense colored wines, sour fruit flavors and soft tannins.

Winemaking:

We define harvest point for the ROSÉ 3 weeks prior to the Malbec we harvest for our red wine. In this way we achieve the right point of expression and acidity. After pressing, it fermented at a low temperature 14 degrees in a steel tank and after its stabilization it fractionated. Always looking for freshness, aromatic expression and on the palate, and the reflection of our terroir.
